Preamble to Resolution to increase members' monthly voluntary subscription

First and foremost, the Section Committee would like to unreservedly thank all the Section members for their strong support of the Section's activities since the Section's revival from the year 2003, especially their monthly voluntary subscription to defray the Section's expenses in carrying out it's activities for the benefit of the members for the past 22 years.

The past and present Section Committees have been managing the Section's funds over the last 22 years prudently to ensure that the section funds are not in deficit despite the escalating costs in recent years.

However, it has now become more difficult to finance the expenses without further depleting the already minimal Section funds, most of which were raised from surpluses from organising Invitational tournaments, to ensure that the Section members continue to enjoy the organised activities.

For the information of all Section members, the monthly voluntary subscription at present is RM3 since 2003, i.e. 22 years without increase. This subscription is among the lowest of all the 11 sporting sections' monthly voluntary subscriptions.
